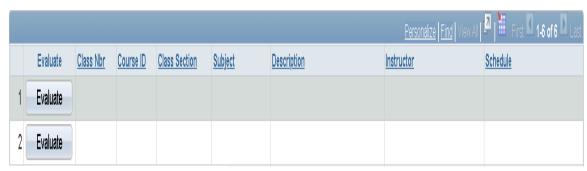


2. Navigate to <u>Student Evaluation of Teaching</u>.

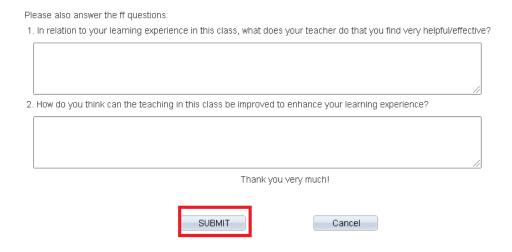

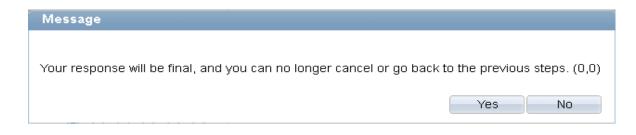

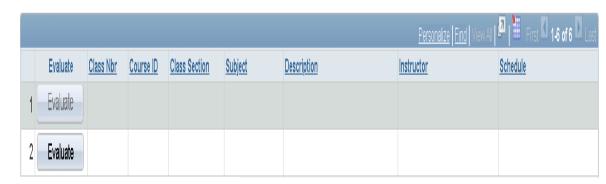
